

## **Longrigg Woodland**

Hello. It has been some time since the original meeting, I am emailing members of the Longrigg Working Group to provide information on the current position.

There was a meeting on the 3<sup>rd</sup> December 2018 to discuss the appointment of the consultants and outline the feasibility and viability study work schedule. At the meeting it was agreed that the full Longrigg Working Group be reconvened; there should be a community drop-in event, and a further meeting to discuss and clarify the consultants' early findings.

A drop-in session was arranged from 2pm - 7pm on Friday 7<sup>th</sup> December in the Village Hall. The consultants were on hand to discuss any aspects and answer questions, and 41 members of the community attended during the day. A meeting is arranged for 7pm on Thursday 7<sup>th</sup> February 2019 in the large community room in the Sunart Community Centre, for the consultants to present their early findings. Therefore, as agreed, all the members of the Longrigg Woodland Working Group are invited to attend. Also invited are the Sunart Community Company directors and the Sunart Community Councillors, and members of the community who wish to attend.

There will be a further meeting of the Longrigg Working Group towards the end of February (the date to be notified) to discuss the consultants' findings in detail and to produce recommendations for the Sunart Community Company Board of Directors. The recommendations will go to the Sunart Community Board in late March 2019 for the final decision.
