- 1. **Welcome**: PS welcomed all to the meeting
- 2. Acceptance of Minutes of last meeting 22nd March 2023 & any matters arising not included in the agenda: There were no items raised (Proposed by JH seconded by PS)

- 6. **Longrigg Woodland Update:** We have had an initial offer from FLS regarding the purchase with a £99,500.00 discount on the original purchase price.
- **7. Mens Shed Update:** The initial tidy up and internal/external painting is complete. Sunart Community Council to provide a grant to complete roof refurbishment and ?????

- 9. Paths Update: Some fencing along Ardnastang path needs to be cleared. JH had a meeting with Lindsey? of FLS regards;
